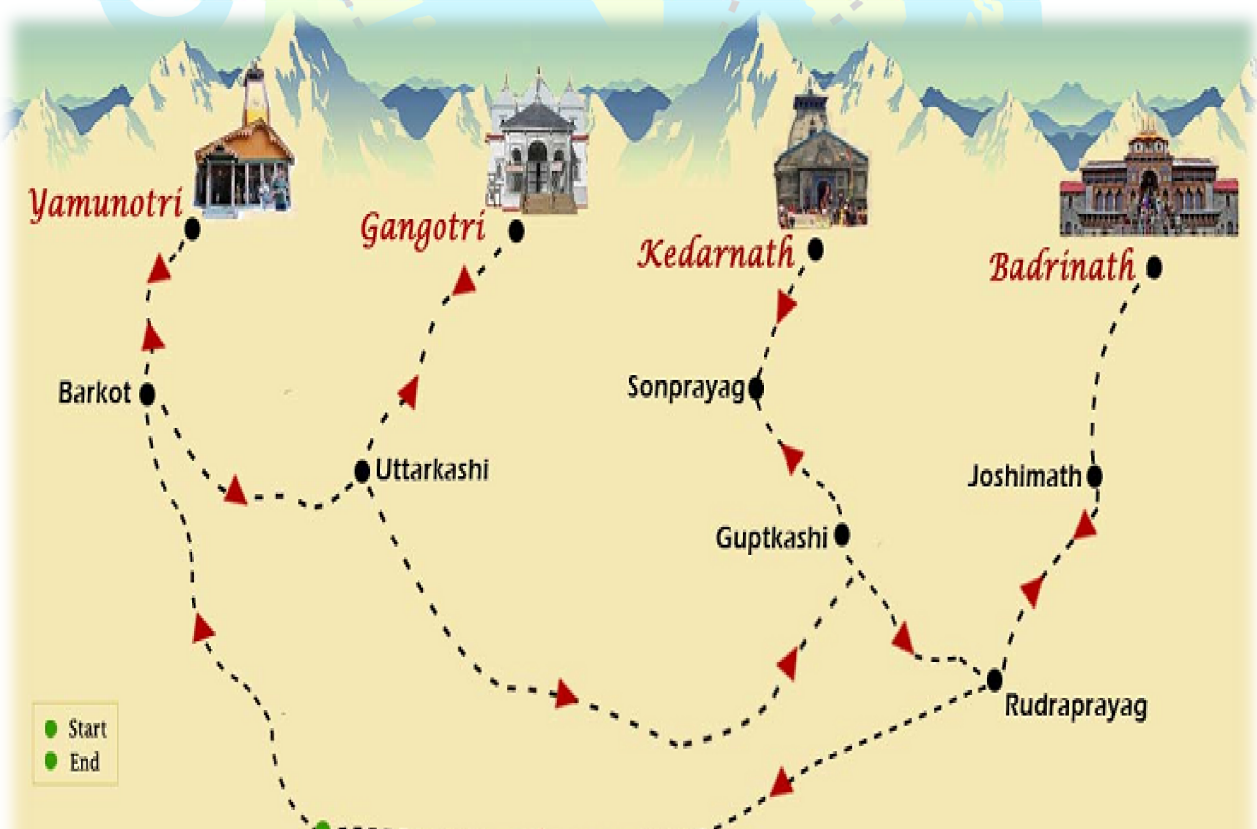

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CHAR DHAM

Uttarakhand, also known as Devbhoomi or the Land of Gods, is home to numerous temples and welcomes devotees all year round. Among the countless religious sites and circuits that devotees visit in Uttarakhand, one of the most prominent is the Char Dham Yatra. This Yatra or pilgrimage is a tour of four holy sites - Yamunotri, Gangotri, Kedarnath and Badrinath – nestled high up in the Himalayas. In Hindi, 'char' means four and 'dham' refers to religious destinations.

The high-altitude shrines remain shut for around six months every year, opening in summers (April or May) and closing with the onset of winter (October or November). It is believed that one should complete the Char Dham Yatra in a clockwise direction. Hence, the pilgrimage starts from Yamunotri, proceeds towards Gangotri, onto Kedarnath, and finally ends at Badrinath. The journey can be completed by road or by air (helicopter services are available). Some devotees even do a Do Dham Yatra or a pilgrimage to two shrines - Kedarnath and Badrinath.

The Yamunotri temple, lodged in a narrow gorge close to the source of River Yamuna (the second-most sacred Indian river after River Ganga) in Uttarkashi district, is dedicated to Goddess Yamuna. The district of Uttarkashi is also home to Gangotri dedicated to Goddess Ganga, the most sacred of all Indian rivers. Located in the Rudraprayag district lies Kedarnath, dedicated to Lord Shiva. Badrinath, home to the sacred Badrinarayan Temple, is dedicated to Lord Vishnu. The Char Dham Yatra is as divine as it is arduous but fulfills the soul!

ITINERARY

Day 01 : Delhi – Haridwar (240 Km / 5 Hour)

Pick up from Delhi Airport / Railway Station or any Prescheduled destination and proceed to Haridwar.

After reaching to hotel freshen up and proceed for sightseeing.

- Har ki Pauri Ghat
- Mata Mansa Devi
- Mata Chandi Devi

Then back to hotel have dinner and Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 02 : Haridwar – Barkot (193 Km / 6-7 Hour)

In the morning after having breakfast proceed for Barkot.

(Barkot is the base point for Yamunotri Dham)

On the way if time permits then we can visit Kempty Falls.

After reaching to hotel freshen up and relax.

Then have dinner and Overnight stay.

Day 03 : Barkot – Yamunotri Darshan – Barkot

In the morning after having breakfast proceed for Janki Chatti.

(Janki Chatti : The last point where vehicle can go)

From Janki Chatti you need to **trek for 6 Km** to reach Yamunotri Dham.

Note : If it's not possible to trek, then there are options of Pony, Palki, etc.

After darshan way back to Janki Chatti following same route, here our driver will be waiting at parking.

Then after reaching to hotel, have dinner and Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 04 : Barkot – Uttarkashi (81 Km / 3-4 Hour)

In the morning after having breakfast, check out the hotel and drive to Uttarkashi.

(Uttarkashi is situated on the banks of river Bhagirathi and is famous for its historical monuments, Temples & Ashrams) En-route visit Kashi Vishwanath Temple.

After reaching to hotel freshen up and relax.

Then have dinner and Overnight stay.

Day 05 : Uttarkashi – Gangotri – Uttarkashi

Morning drive to Gangotri. Upon arrival at Gangotri take a holy dip in the sacred river Ganges (which is also called Bhagirathi at its origin. After performing Pooja, drive back to Uttarkashi. Dinner & Overnight stay at Uttarkashi.

Day 06 : Uttarkashi – Guptkashi (200 Km / 7-8 Hour)

In the morning after having breakfast,, check out the hotel and drive to Guptkashi (It's situated at a distance of 47 km from the holy shrine, Kedarnath)

The town holds immense religious importance.

In the evening have your dinner and stay overnight in the hotel.

Day 07 : Guptkashi – Kedarnath

In the morning after having breakfast proceed for Kedarnath.

Road Route : After breakfast our driver will pick you and will proceed till sonprayag, then from their take Union taxi operated by Kedarnath management till Gaurikund. Now at Gaurikund take a dip at holy water and start your trek to Kedarnath Dham.

Note : If it's not possible to trek, then there are options of Pony, Palki, etc.

Helicopter Route : After breakfast our driver will take you at respected Helipads according to your helicopter ticket. From their take chopper and land at Kedarnath Dham helipad.

After reaching to Kedarnath Dham, Check in your Hotel, dormitory, camps.
Then freshen up and attend the evening Aarti of Kedarnath Baba.
In the evening have dinner and Overnight stay at Kedarnath Ji.

Day 08 : Kedarnath – Guptkashi

In the morning after performing morning rituals and having breakfast proceed for Guptkashi following same route.

After reaching to hotel freshen up and relax.
In the evening have dinner and Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 09 : Guptkashi – Badrinath (194 Km / 6-7 Hour)

In the morning after having breakfast proceed for Badrinath.
After reaching to hotel freshen up and relax.
Then proceed for evening aarti of Badrinath Ji.
In the evening have dinner and Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 10 : Badrinath – Rishikesh (284 Km / 8-9 Hour)

In the morning after performing morning rituals and having breakfast proceed for Rishikesh.
If time permits visit Mana Village and Sangams on the way.
After reaching to hotel freshen up and relax.
Then have dinner and Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 11 : Rishikesh – Delhi (258 Km / 5-6 Hour)

In the morning after having breakfast proceed back to Delhi.

If time permits Visit Laxman Jhula , Ram Jhula
